## A CENTURY OF LEGAL EDUCATION

New Brunswick's first law school was founded in Saint John by a small group of lawyers and judges on Oct. 8, 1892. For the first 60 years, members of the Saint John bench and practising bar were its lecturers and administrators. Early students included some of the first Canadian women to study law (1893), as well as some of the first black law students (1892) and first Asians (1916). The school was affiliated with King's College in Windsor, N.S., until it became a faculty of UNB in Fredericton in 1923.

Housed on the upper floor of the Provincial Building in Saint John from 1897, the Law School moved in 1953 into the Starr family home--purchased for that purpose by Lord Beaverbrook and named Beaverbrook House--where it remained until 1959. Following a decision to integrate the school with the university in Fredericton, the school moved in 1959 to Somerville House, also provided by Lord Beaverbrook, and into Ludlow Hall on the Fredericton campus in 1969.

UNB's faculty of law has educated the overwhelming majority of lawyers and judges in New Brunswick and has graduates in every Canadian province. UNB graduates make up about one-third of the Bar of Prince Edward Island and one quarter of the Bar of Newfoundland and sit on the bench in eight provinces and in the Federal Court and Supreme Court of Canada. They are also leaders in public service and in their profession locally and nationally.
