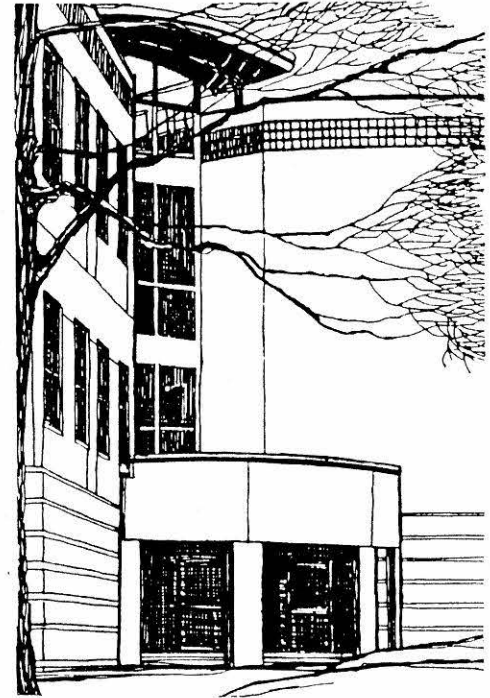

Following the ceremony, graduates, guests, and the public are cordially invited to attend the Tree Planting in the Quadrangle outside Philip W. Oland Hall, the Convocation Tea in the Baird Dining Room, and to view the Exhibition in the Art Gallery.

Although Latin has long ceased to be the language of instruction for all university courses, as it once was at Oxford and Cambridge, at Paris, and Bologna, it is traditional to retain it for limited use on occasions of great academic solemnity, such as university convocations. The use of Latin today is a symbol of our academic descent from these earliest universities of mediaeval Europe and a humble reminder that the search for truth is both new and ancient.
