HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT**Glenn Cooke, Doctor of Science**

Born and raised in Blacks Harbour, N.B., Glenn Cooke is CEO of the largest fully integrated and independent salmon farming company in North America, Cooke Aquaculture Inc.

In 1985, together with his father and brother, he began a new venture of raising farmed Atlantic salmon in the Bay of Fundy. The one marine cage site containing 5,000 salmon has grown to 25 million fish. Today, the company has 2,000 employees and operations in New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island, Quebec, Newfoundland and Maine. The company also owns Salmenes Cupquellan in Chile. In addition, Cooke Aquaculture Inc. partners with a UNB Saint John researcher and his team on the development of integrated multi-trophic aquaculture systems.

Mr. Cooke's vision, entrepreneurship and business savvy have been recognized with a number of awards. In 2006, Cooke Aquaculture Inc. was first named as one of the 50 Best Managed Companies in Canada and has been renamed to that list for every year since. In 2007, Mr. Cooke was named Entrepreneur of the Year for Atlantic Canada and has since been named as one of Atlantic Canada's top 50 CEOs for several consecutive years. In 2009, Cooke was inducted into New Brunswick's Junior Achievement Business Hall of Fame. Cooke Aquaculture was also recognized by the Maine International Trade Association as the State's International Investor of the Year in 2009 and received Export Achievement and Community Development awards in Nova Scotia in 2010.

Glenn Cooke has been a trailblazer in the field of aquaculture in New Brunswick and Canada. For several terms, he served as President of the New Brunswick Salmon Growers' Association.

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT

Hans W. Klohn, *Doctor of Science*

Hans W. Klohn was born in Kiel, Germany. In 1952 he moved to Saint John, N.B. to work on the Irving Pulp and Paper Mill expansion project. His engineering skills and exemplary leadership abilities were quickly recognized by K.C. Irving, who named Mr. Klohn manager of this project.

In 1955, Mr. Klohn was named the first president of Ocean Steel and Construction Limited (OSCO). Under his leadership the company saw rapid growth. From Newfoundland, and along the eastern Atlantic seaboard to New York City, Mr. Klohn has applied his engineering and construction abilities where we drive, work and live. The Queen's Court building in Halifax, N.S.; the N.B. Power Generating Station in Belledune, N.B.; the Saint John Harbour Bridge; Harbour Station; and the Saint John Regional Hospital are just a few examples of construction projects overseen by Hans W. Klohn.

In addition, Mr. Klohn played a pivotal role in bringing John E. (Jack) and Arthur Irving's project to restore the Old Burial Ground in Saint John to completion. He was named one of only three Honorary Life Members to the Saint John Construction Association in 2002.

His commitment to community development has been consistent with Ocean Steel's involvement in various charities and support of education, including: the Boys and Girls Club of Saint John, Inc.; Romero House; Children's Wish Foundation and a bursary program for the children of Irving company employees. Mr. Klohn took a keen interest in all aspects of the construction of the K.C. Irving Hall on UNB's Saint John campus, and has lent his expertise in the development of its Commons Project.

Mr. Klohn's four children and three of his grandchildren are graduates of UNB.

ABOUT THE CONVOCATION CEREMONY

The Convocation Procession

The word "convocation" means "calling together," and UNB's convocation is truly a gathering of all individuals who are part of the University – students, professors, administrators, staff, alumni, families and friends. The ceremony starts with the procession of students, special guests, faculty, members of the Senate and of the Board of Governors, the honorary degree recipient(s), the President and Vice-Chancellor, the Chancellor and the Lieutenant-Governor of New Brunswick.

The Stage

All of the formalities around convocation take place on the stage. The stage is occupied by the Lieutenant-Governor, representatives of the Federal, Provincial and Municipal governments, the University's Chancellor, the President and Vice-Chancellor, members of the University's Board of Governors, University officials such as Vice-Presidents, Deans, University alumni, those holding emeritus status and the honorary degree recipient(s). The flags at the side of the stage represent the countries that are home to the international students currently studying at UNB Saint John. The banners displayed on the stage represent the various faculties and/or schools in which students may study at UNB Saint John.

Academic Dress

It is part of the ceremony to wear the academic dress of the institution. It is for this reason that all of the students wear the gown, hood and cap, as do most of the University's faculty and officials. At UNB Saint John, the University's alumni are also invited to wear their academic attire and join the procession.

The Ceremonial Mace

The mace symbolizes the authority of the University to award degrees. Introduced in 1996, UNB's ceremonial mace features an antique silver cup atop a wooden shaft. The George II two-handled cup was given to the University in 1995 by S.A.H. Bridge, the great-great-grandson of Sir Howard Douglas, Bart. Sir Howard, Lieutenant-Governor of New Brunswick from 1823 to 1831, was instrumental in gaining the University's Royal charter.

The shaft was created by New Brunswick artisan Michiel Oudemans. Crafted from butternut, a wood indigenous to the province, it features elements of the UNB coat of arms and symbols of New Brunswick: the University motto, Sapere aude (Dare to know); a book of learning; beavers (in honour of Lord Beaverbrook, the University's first modern-day Chancellor); a galley; fiddleheads; and Atlantic salmon.

The mace is carried in the procession by the University Secretary.

The dress worn by each participant depends upon the academic level attained, with special attire for Bachelors, Masters and Doctors. While tradition has indicated the style or cut of the academic attire, each university amends certain details to suit its particular tastes and traditions.

Following is a guide to UNB's ceremonial dress:
