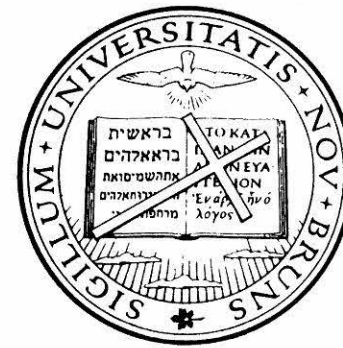

At the beginning of Convocation the audience is requested to stand when the Academic Procession arrives and to remain standing until the close of the Prayer of Invocation. At the close of Convocation, following the singing of *O Canada*, the audience should remain standing until the Academic Procession has left.

Graduates are asked to remain in their seats until the Convocation ceremony is complete as a sign of respect and consideration for their classmates.

The Academic Procession is piped into The Richard J. CURRIE CENTER by Murray McEachen.

Music for the 58th Convocation is provided by the Saint John String Quartet (David Adams and Laurissa Chitty, violins; Christopher Buckley, viola; and Sonja Adams, cello) with Robert Dutton, trumpet.

Following the ceremony, graduates, their guests and ceremony participants are cordially invited to a Convocation Reception in the Atrium of the Student Union Building.

Although Latin has long ceased to be the language of instruction for all university courses, as it once was at Oxford and Cambridge, at Paris and Bologna, we have retained it at UNB for limited use on occasions of great academic solemnity, such as university convocations. The use of Latin today is a symbol of our academic descent from those earliest universities of medieval Europe and a humble reminder that the search for truth is both ancient and new.

The Mace

The mace, which symbolizes the authority of the University to award degrees, was officially used for the first time at UNB's 167th Encaenia in May 1996.

A gift of the University's Chancellor, Fredrik S. Eaton, O.C., the mace was proposed by the late Colin B. Mackay, O.C., Q.C., President Emeritus. It measures 4.5 feet in length and features an antique silver cup atop a butternut shaft.

The George II, two-handled cup was given to the University in 1995 by S. A. H. Bridge, the great-great-grandson of Sir Howard Douglas, Bar't. It was once part of a collection of fine silverware presented to Sir Howard by the people of New Brunswick when he returned to England, after serving as Lieutenant-Governor (1823-1831). During his term, Sir Howard took great interest in the institution then known as the College of New Brunswick. He persuaded the British government to grant it a Royal charter, as King's College, and to provide half the funding for the construction of what is now the oldest university building still in use in Canada.

The cup, hallmarked LONDON 1734, is predated by its cover which bears a 1728 hallmark. The armorial engraving on the upper half of the cup and the crest and motto on the cover are those of Douglas of Kirkness, County Kinross.

New Brunswick artisan Michiel Oudemans created the staff for the mace. Crafted from butternut, a wood indigenous to the province, the staff features elements of the UNB coat of arms and symbols of New Brunswick: a book of learning, beavers (in honour of Lord Beaverbrook, the University's first modern-day Chancellor), a galley, fiddleheads, and Atlantic salmon.

The UNB Coin

Introduced on the occasion of the university's 225th anniversary, the UNB coin was first presented to members of the graduating class in May 2011. Each limited edition coin is inscribed with the UNB logo, crest, motto — *Sapere Aude* (Dare to be Wise) — and year.

Graduates, it is our hope that this coin will serve as reminder of your experiences at UNB, the journey you took in reaching your goal, and that you are — and will always be — part of the UNB family.

Official Opening

At the beginning of each graduation ceremony, before the mace is set on its ceremonial stand by the University Secretary, the President will petition the Chancellor to begin the ceremony.
