**A**t the beginning of Convocation the audience is requested to stand when the Academic Procession arrives and to remain standing until the close of the Petition by the President. At the close of the Convocation ceremony, following the singing of *O Canada*, the audience should remain standing until the Academic Procession has left the stage.

**G**raduates are asked to remain in their seats until the Convocation ceremonies are completed as a sign of respect and consideration for their classmates.

**A**lthough Latin has long ceased to be the language of instruction for all university courses, as it once was at Oxford and Cambridge, at Paris and Bologna, we have retained it at UNB for limited use on occasions of great academic solemnity, such as university convocations. The use of Latin today is a symbol of our academic descent from those earliest universities of medieval Europe and a humble reminder that the search for truth is both ancient and new.

**I**ntroduced on the occasion of the university's 225<sup>th</sup> anniversary, the UNB coin was first presented to members of the graduating class in May 2011. Each limited edition coin is inscribed with the UNB logo, crest, motto – *Sapere Aude* (Dare to be Wise) – and year.

**G**raduates, it is our hope that this coin will serve as a reminder of your experiences at UNB, the journey you took in reaching your goal, and that you are – and will always be – part of the UNB family.

## **HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT**

### **Stephen A. Jarislowsky, Doctor of Science**

Stephen A. Jarislowsky was born in Berlin, Germany in September 1925. He attended public and high school in the Netherlands and France before immigrating to the United States in 1941. He attended preparatory school in Asheville, North Carolina, studied mechanical engineering at Cornell University and then served in the U.S. Army. After completing basic training, he studied Japanese at the University of Chicago then served in Counter-Intelligence in Japan after the War.

Dr. Jarislowsky graduated with a MA and Phi Beta Kappa Honours from the University of Chicago. He received his MBA, with distinction, from Harvard Business School in 1949.

After working with Alcan Aluminium in Montreal, he started Jarislowsky, Fraser Limited in June 1955. As chairman and former president, for nearly 60 years he directed the growth of the company to become one of the largest and most successful investment management firms in Canada. As recognition of his outstanding achievements, Stephen Jarislowsky was inducted into the Canadian Business Hall of Fame.

He is a Companion of the Order of Canada, a Grand Officier de L'Ordre National du Québec, and holds honorary degrees from Queens University, University of Alberta, l'Université de Montréal, McMaster University, Concordia University, Assumption University, l'Université Laval, University of Ottawa, Simon Fraser University, McGill University, Mount Saint Vincent and l'Université du Québec.

He has been a director of some 30 companies, including, SNC-Lavalin, Canadian Marconi, Abitibi Consolidated, Southam, Unimedia, The Daily Telegraph (UK), Didier Refractories, Swiss Bank Corporation, Canon Canada, Velan Inc. and Canfor (formerly Slocan). He is former Chairman of Goodfellow Inc. and remains a Director.

He is the co-founder and director of the Canadian Coalition for Good Governance, the Institut sur la gouvernance d'organisations privées et publiques, FAIR Canada and four University Chairs for Corporate Governance. He holds the International Entrepreneur Award from the University of Manitoba, Corporate Director Lifelong Achievement Award, and the Fellow of the Institute of Corporate Directors.

Dr. Jarislowsky has supported educational, cultural and charitable endeavors, endowing more than 24 University Chairs, including the Jarislowsky Chair in Interprofessional Patient-Centred Care located at UNB Saint John. He has created endowments in other Canadian organizations such as the Banff Centre and the Montreal Museum of Fine Arts.

He frequently contributes to television, radio, magazines and newspapers, and is the author of *The Investment Zoo: Taming the Bulls and the Bears*, which was published in 2005.

His hobbies include: his family, gardening, walking, good wine, music, art and literature.

**ABOUT THE CONVOCATION CEREMONY**

**The Convocation Procession**

The word “convocation” means “calling together,” and UNB’s convocation is truly a gathering of all individuals who are part of the University – students, professors, administrators, staff, alumni, families and friends. The ceremony starts with the procession of students, special guests, faculty, members of the Senate and of the Board of Governors, the honorary degree recipient(s), the President and Vice-Chancellor, the Chancellor and the Lieutenant-Governor of New Brunswick.

**The Stage**

All of the formalities around convocation take place on the stage. The stage is occupied by the Lieutenant-Governor, representatives of the Federal, Provincial and Municipal governments, the University’s Chancellor, the President and Vice-Chancellor, members of the University’s Board of Governors, University officials such as Vice-Presidents, Deans, University alumni, those holding emeritus status and the honorary degree recipient(s). The flags at the side of the stage represent the countries that are home to the international students currently studying at UNB Saint John. The banners displayed on the stage represent the various faculties and/or schools in which students may study at UNB Saint John.

**Academic Dress**

It is part of the ceremony to wear the academic dress of the institution. It is for this reason that all of the students wear the gown, hood and cap, as do most of the University’s faculty and officials. At UNB Saint John, the University’s alumni are also invited to wear their academic attire and join the procession.

**The Ceremonial Mace**

The mace symbolizes the authority of the University to award degrees. Introduced in 1996, UNB’s ceremonial mace features an antique silver cup atop a wooden shaft. The George II two-handled cup was given to the University in 1995 by S.A.H. Bridge, the great-great-grandson of Sir Howard Douglas, Bar<sup>t</sup>. Sir Howard, Lieutenant-Governor of New Brunswick from 1823 to 1831, was instrumental in gaining the University’s Royal charter.

The shaft was created by New Brunswick artisan Michiel Oudemans. Crafted from butternut, a wood indigenous to the province, it features elements of the UNB coat of arms and symbols of New Brunswick: the University motto, Sapere aude (Dare to know); a book of learning; beavers (in honour of Lord Beaverbrook, the University’s first modern-day Chancellor); a galley; fiddleheads; and Atlantic salmon.

The mace is carried in the procession by the University Secretary.

All graduates and members of the academic procession are attired in the basic elements of academic dress – the academic robe, the hood and the mortar board or Tudor hat. The dress worn by each participant depends upon the academic level attained, with special attire for Bachelors, Masters and Doctors. While tradition has indicated the style or cut of the academic attire, each university amends certain details to suit its particular tastes and traditions.

Following is a guide to UNB's ceremonial dress:
